

## WDBRFP-011 Strategic Planner In-School Career Counseling Program Submitted Questions

Q: Within the contract period, will I be able to have a pilot of the proposal with a selected group of stakeholders?

**A: This question is unclear.**

Q: The RFP is fairly broad. Can you elaborate on any deliverables you are expecting?

**A: Page five (5) of the RFP outlines the requested scope of work.**

Q: How many people are on the team including WDB, PGCPs, and PGCC (thinking about space requirements)? How much influence will I have in adding representatives to the team?

**A: The team, depending on topic, includes about twenty (20) people. You may recommend additional representatives.**

Q: Will I be able to hire subcontractors that I don't include on the initial proposal? I am thinking specifically about a graphic artist and a videographer. I will stay within the budget.

**A: You may include subcontractors and should include this information in your narrative and proposed budget.**

Q: For the 13 in demand industries, has there already been any outreach to gauge interest for the pathways from employers?

**A: Employ Prince George's, Prince George's Community College, and Prince George's County Public Schools all have existing relationships and an infrastructure with businesses in the community. There has not been a business survey related to the Blueprint for Maryland's Future to date.**

Q: Are you looking for pathway programs for each of the 13 targeted industries listed in the RFP?

**A: The target industries are organized into six (6) clusters. The career counseling program will address all six (6) clusters.**
